How to signup and be part of the “Find a Unit Help” system

iHub for Circle Ten Shooting Sports

With the move from MyScoutlink.com (MSL) to InspireHub (iHub) the email process we had been using for the “Find Unit Help” has to change.

With MSL when you signed up for a class we asked you a lot a questions to determine what level (units, districts, OA, Venturing, council) you were willing to help with. Also we tracked what certifications you had from attending our classes.

With the new iHub, this is no longer possible. Instead the council has created new Shooting Sports Update channels.

- Archery/BB Gun
- RSO
- Shotgun
- Muzzleloading
- Rifle
- Pistol

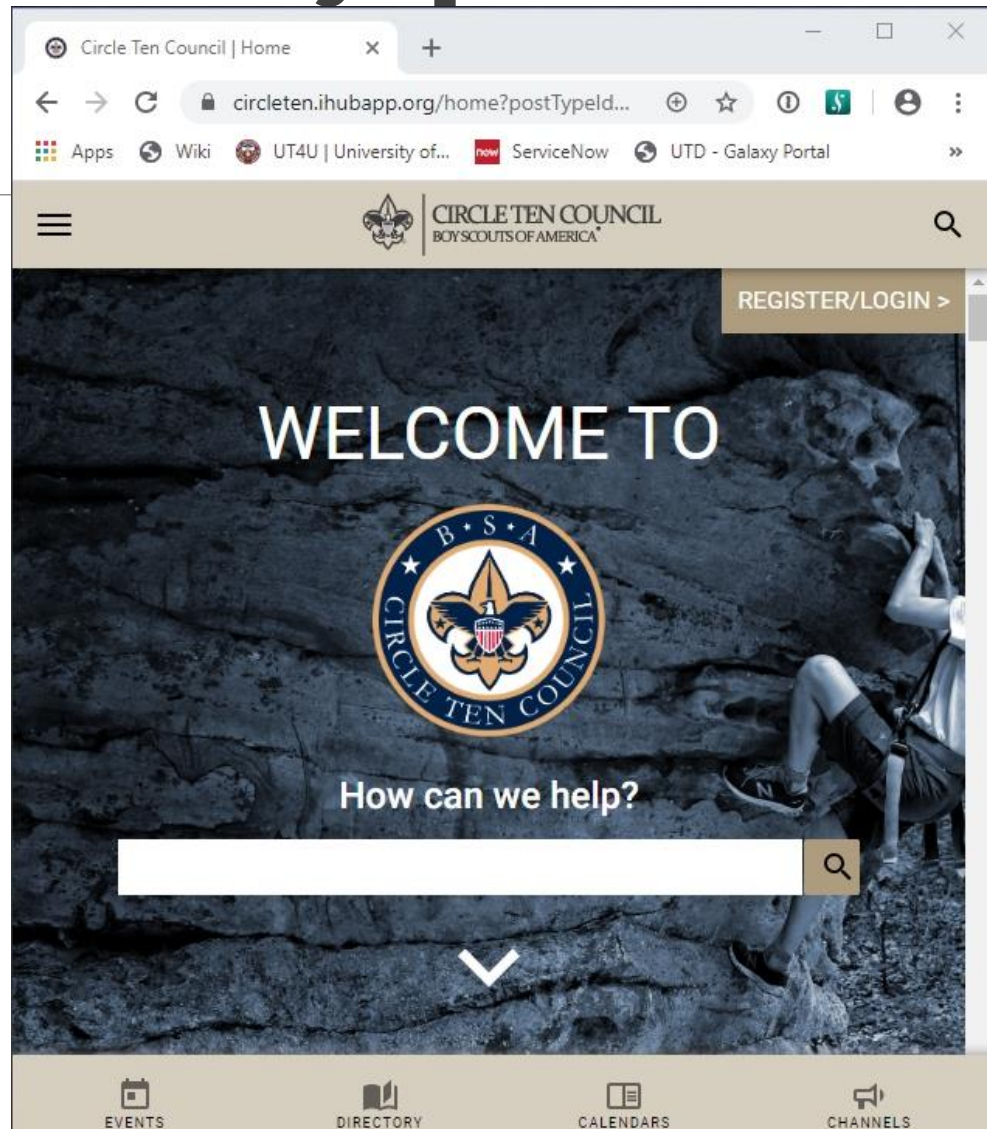
Now anyone wishing to continue with the “Find Unit Help” program must register with the iHub, and then add the specific channels they wish to receive notifications of help requests from.

Step 1. Register an account on iHub. In your browser go to

https://circleten.ihubapp.org/home?postTypeId=what_sNew

If you don't have an account already or weren't signed on you will get the screen:

Step 2: Either Login with your userid and password or if you don't have an account near the bottom is a link to create an account "Register"


If creating an account click that link.

Step 3: Enter your email address on the screen and click the I accept the Terms of service checkbox.


Then click the REGISTER button

Step 4: It will send an email to that email with a 6 digit code. Enter that code

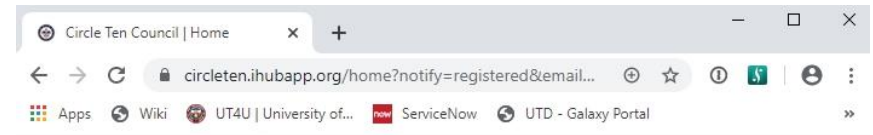

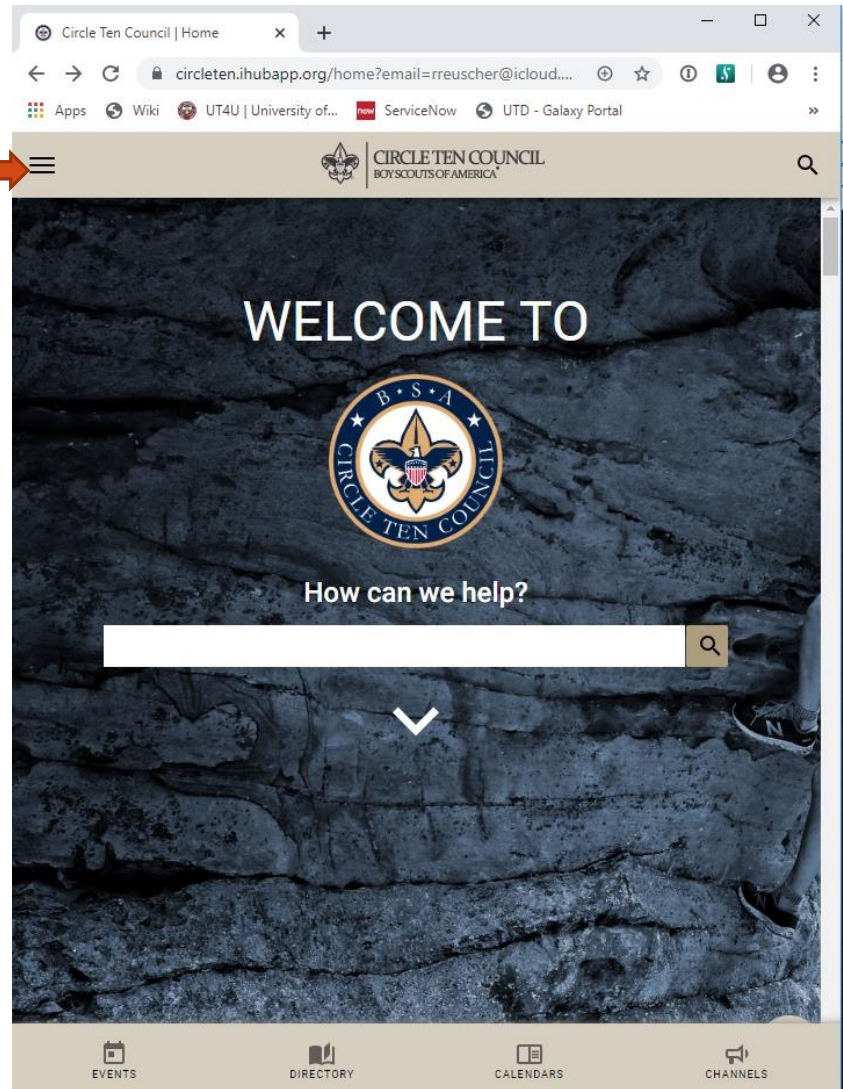

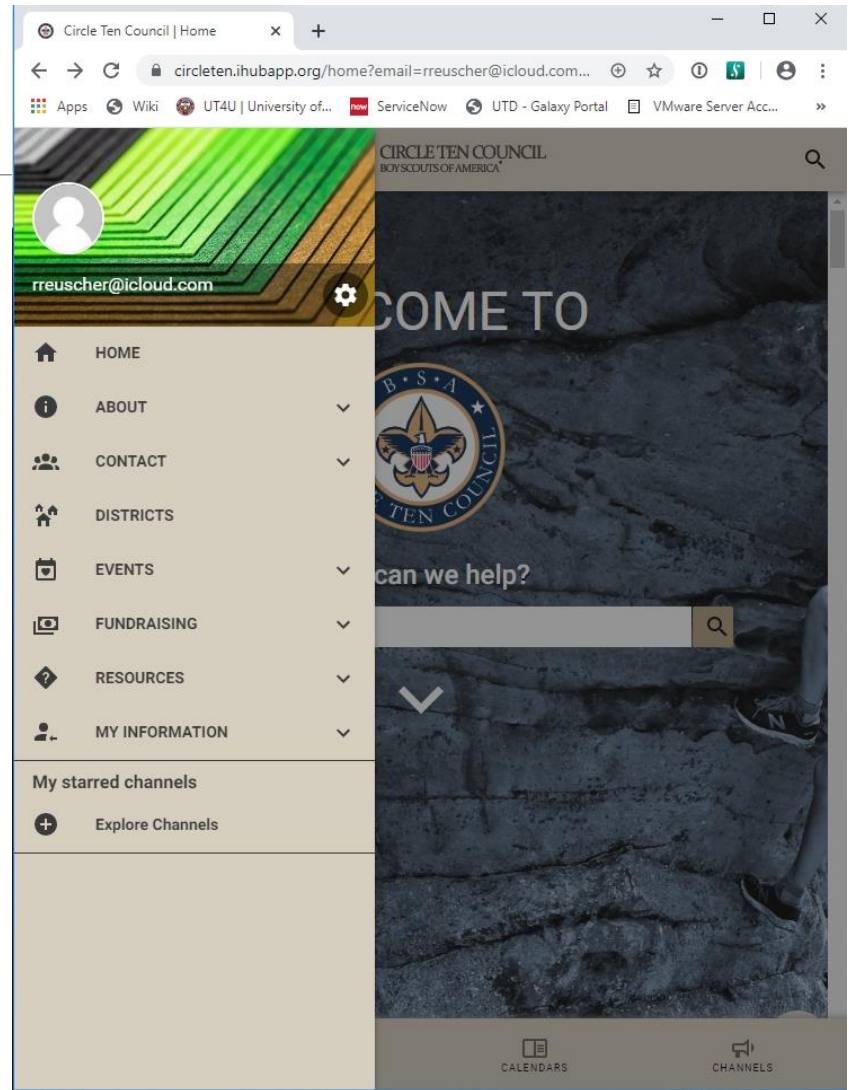

Step 8: Once you created your account it will take you back to the main page. Now you want to join our channels. The first to look at is the main Shooting Sports channel. To do this click the “hamburger menu” that’s the three horizontal lines near the top (see arrow in graphic)



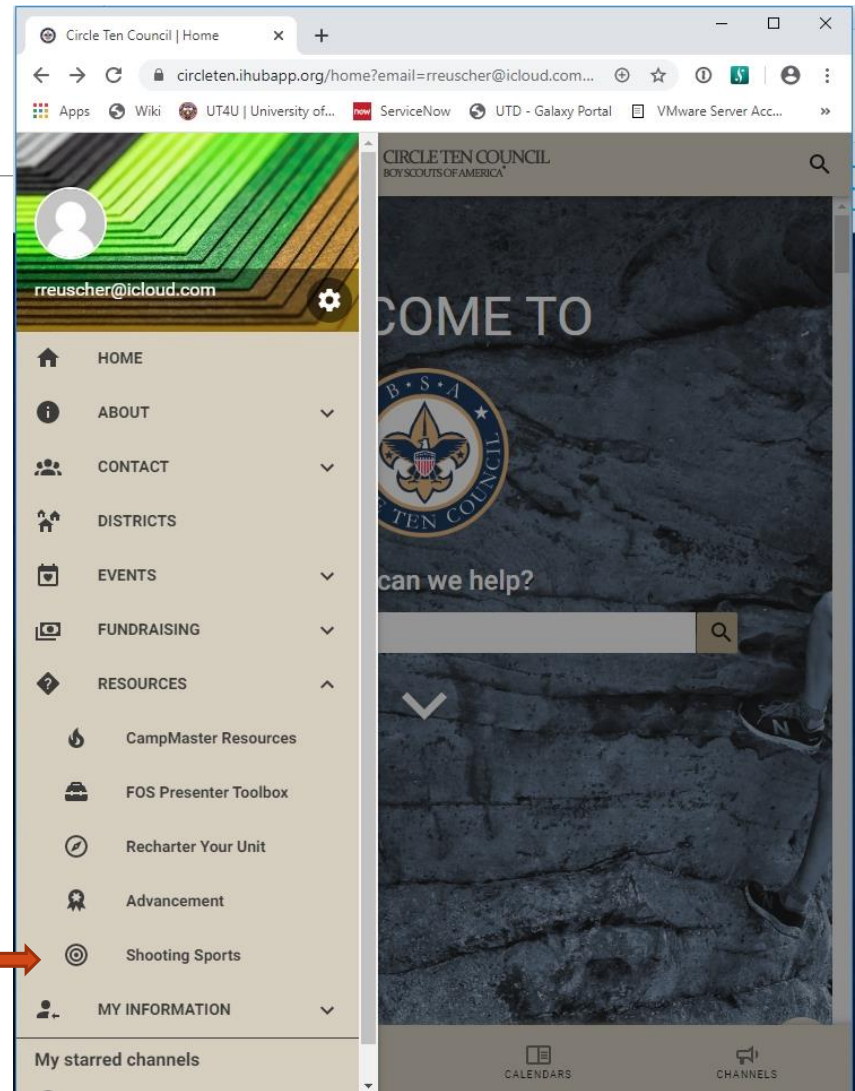

Welcome to our new page for all things "shooting sports" in Circle Ten Council! We offer NRA, USA Archery and BSA certification classes.

- NRA certifications are used in Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts and Exploring events where firearms are used (rifles, shotguns, pistols, etc...) Leaders with NRA Rifle Instructor can teach and certify other Scout leaders for the BSA BB gun Rangemaster certification.
- USA Archery certifications are used in Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts and Exploring related archery events. Leaders with USA Archery Level I can teach and certify other Scout leaders for the BSA Archery Rangemaster certification.
- BSA certifications are used in Cub Scouting BB gun or archery events (leaders with NRA or USA Archery certifications can also run these events). A leader with BSA Archery Rangemaster certification can open and run a range at a Scouts BSA event, but cannot be



Step 13: On this page it will list all of our help request update channels. These are the channels you must join in order to continue to receive the help requests.

Click JOIN for the areas you want to receive help from. When you do it will change from JOIN to MEMBER



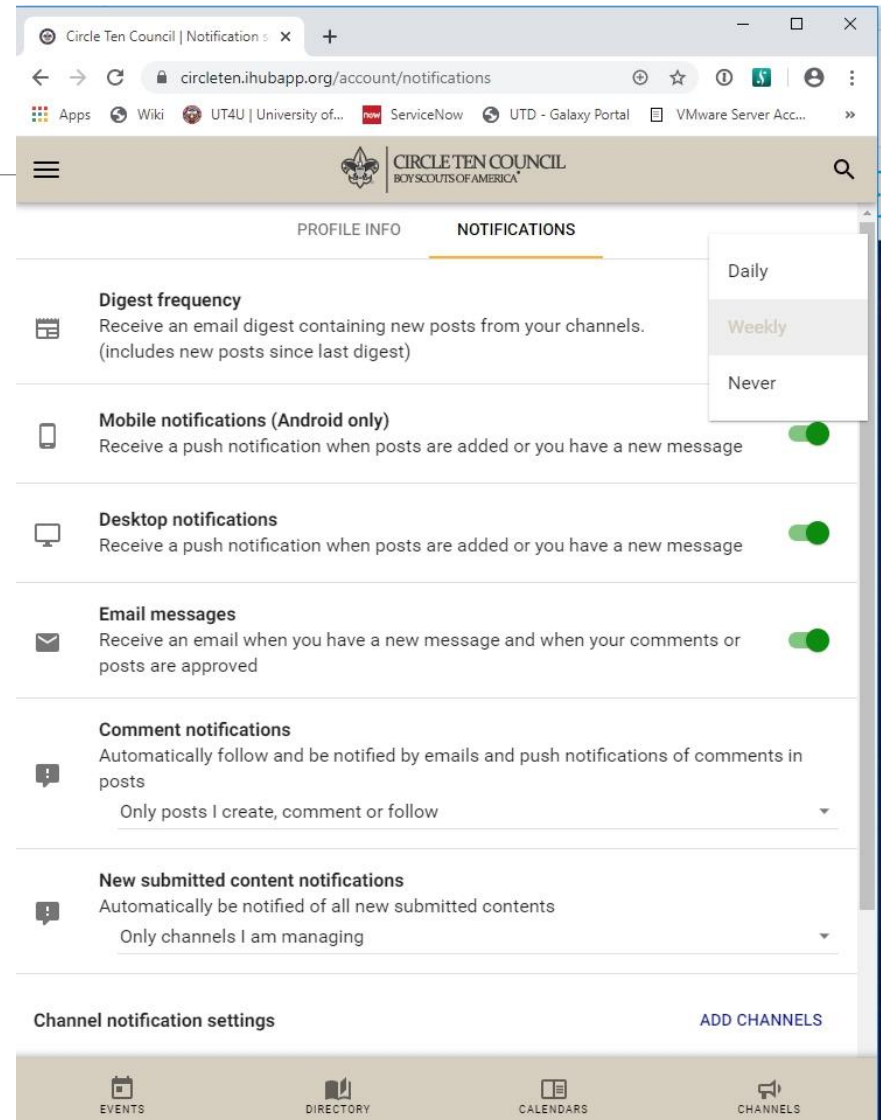

Step 14: Once you've joined the channels you want to get notifications from you probably want to change the frequency or method of notifications. To do this open the "hamburger" menu again and click on "MY INFORMATION" then Account. At the top of this page are two tabs "PROFILE INFO" and NOTIFICATIONS. You can fill in the Profile info if you want, but we are looking at the notifications tab.



Step 15: The default digest setting is Weekly,

I'd suggest you set it to Daily. This way every morning you will receive notifications of updates to all your channels. I believe never sends you notifications immediately so if you have a lot of channels you could get lots of notifications.

I find Daily works well. I get an email every day with all that has happened on all my channels yesterday. I can then pick and chose which one(s) of those I want more information on. The slider buttons below this set how this notification occurs. On my primary account I have Mobile and Desktop turned off. Email is on.

The notification settings are as follows:
